Directions to Site

Showalter East Field, Cady Way, Winter Park:

From I-4, take Exit #87 (Fairbanks Ave./S.R. 426) east and continue past Hwy 17-92. At the point where Orange Ave. merges from the right (just after the railroad tracks), bear to your left (there is a light here). Continue winding through Winter Park – after a last hard curve to the right, the street name becomes Aloma Ave. Continue past Lakemont Ave to Ranger Rd. Turn right on Ranger, light just before S.R. 436, and go to Cady Way. Turn right on Cady Way. The park is just past Cornwall Rd. on your right. You will see a school ahead on the left and a stadium (Showalter Field) on the right. The trial site is on the right just BEFORE you get to the stadium.

From the Central Florida Greenway (S.R. 417), get off at the University Blvd. exit and go west on University until you get to S.R. 436 (Semoran Blvd.). Continue straight across S.R. 436 – the road you are on becomes Scarlet Rd. Continue straight on Scarlet – the road will curve left and become Cornwall Rd. At the stop sign, turn right onto Cady Way. The park is immediately on your right. You will see a school ahead on the left and a stadium (Showalter Field) on the right. The trial site is on the right just BEFORE you get to the stadium. .

OR

Get off the Greenway (S.R. 417) at Aloma Ave. and go west on Aloma. Continue across S.R. 436 until you get to Ranger Rd. (first light after you cross 436). Turn left on Ranger and go to Cady Way. Turn right on Cady Way. The park is just past Cornwall Rd. on your right. You will see a school ahead on the left and a stadium (Showalter Field) on the right. The trial site is on the right just BEFORE you get to the stadium.

Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age, regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA[®] Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

Entries For Exhibition Only will not be accepted. Should a dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measure-in, it will be placed first in the running order at the higher height for all classes entered.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Overpayments

Overpayments of \$10 or less will not be refunded. Please check your entry amount carefully for accuracy.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

General Entry Conditions

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Titling Class & Tournament Awards

Titling Classes - Ribbons for 1st through 3rd place will be awarded in each jump height (and for mini and open in pairs). Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score in any non-tournament classes. Title Ribbons will also be available.

Tournaments

Grand Prix & Performance GP: 1st through 3rd placement ribbons will be awarded in each jump height for both tournaments. Each competitor earning a qualifying score will receive an overlay qualifying ribbon, with the first place qualifier also receiving a regional bye voucher.

Steeplechase & Performance Speed Jumping: Special qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all competitors earning a qualifying score in Round 1. Prize money will be paid in accordance with the payout chart found in tournament rules at www.usdaa.com.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

If your dog is in need of measuring you must have this done during the measuring time above. There will be a CMJ available and he has other duties as well as measuring and most likely will NOT be available at a later time. You will need to make the necessary arrangements to be measured PRIOR to checking in.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may opt to run the dog in the lower jump height class "For Exhibition Only", and no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).
