

CHIEF COURSE BUILDER (DOI Trial Position)

Prior to trial

- If entering the trial, contact the Trial Chair to determine the number of runs and to verify that 1 dog/day's worth of entries will be free, with no AKC/USDAA fees.

During the Trial

- Prior to the start of the trial or on the evening before the trial, assist with setting up ring gating and build first course(s) using coordinates on map provided by the judge.
- Work with Volunteer and Cadet Coordinators to assist in course building throughout the trial.
- Communicate to Cadet Coordinator when and how many Cadet workers will be needed for a course build. Ensure communication is done through the Coordinator and not directly with the cadets, there are different crews for different responsibilities and the cadets should be managed through the coordinator.
- Throughout each day of the trial, build courses using maps provided by the judge.
- Walk with judge as course is tweaked and assist as needed.
- During the final day of the trial, communicate with the equipment manager when equipment can be put away as it is no longer needed in the ring.
- At the end of the trial assist with storing equipment.
- Work with the Volunteer Coordinator to distribute DOI bucks or raffle tickets if these are being used to "pay" volunteers.

Compensation:

- One dog/day **free entry**. No AKC/USDAA fees to be paid, pending continued good economic standing of DOI.
- Coordinate with Trial Chair and/or Trial Secretary to determine number of runs as these can vary by trial.
