I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for the loss of a dog by any disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog. Whether such loss be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the DOG-ON-IT Agility Club of Central Florida or any of the aforementioned parties. I (we) assume all responsibility for any such loss or expense. This release form will remain in effect permanently unless otherwise waived by the property owners/Dog-On-It Agility Club of Club of Central Florida.

# Dog-On-It Agility Club of Central Florida ("DOI")

#### FIELD RULES

**Hours of Operation**: Except when reserved for classes or special events, the field is available 7 days per week, and any and all lights must be off by midnight.

Who May Use the Field: Only field members, authorized instructors, or students during classes taught by authorized instructors.

**Safety First**: Do not allow your dogs on the equipment unless you are taking or have taken agility classes and know the safe way to train your dog. DOI is not responsible for injuries incurred from the use or misuse of the equipment.

Only one dog off leash in a ring at a time. Other dogs must be under restraint and supervision of owner (i.e. leash, crate, x-pen, owner's arms, etc.). If a dog is tied out, it must be at least 10 feet from the agility rings. If a dog is left in a vehicle, it must not be able to leave the vehicle. All dogs on premises must be current on vaccinations, as recommended by their veterinarian.

**Sharing the Practice Ring**: If more than one person is present, practice no more than 10 minutes per person and take turns.

## **General Rules:**

Only DOI equipment may be used. Equipment/training space rented to another instructor may not be used by members except in that instructor's classes.

Pick up after your dogs and dispose of your trash.

Dogs should no eliminate in the agility ring or on the equipment. Clean any equipment that is soiled.

Discard trash and dog waste in the trash can. This applies to anywhere on the premises, whether inside or outside of the fenced area.

No overnight parking or camping other than permitted R.V.s at a show, match or seminar.

To create a healthier environment, please refrain from smoking. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the NOCIA grounds.

No open fires permitted on the premises at any time.

No sustained loud noise after 11:00 p.m.

Everyone must comply with all state, county, and municipal laws and ordinances.

#### When leaving the field:

- 1. Tuck the chute in the barrel
- 2. All contact equipment should be left in a usable condition a minimum of 10 feet away from the fence line.
- 3. Turn off all lights
- 4. Turn off water faucet and empty the pool
- 5. Make sure all trash is disposed of properly
- 6. VERY IMPORTANT: LOCK ALL GATES TO THE PRACTICE FIELD.

Enforcement: Any violations of the clubs policies should be reported to the Board of Directors. Members who violate these rules may have their field privileges revoked without a refund.

Non-members: Club members may bring the same guest twice in on year at no cost. After that, the guest will be required to join the club and become a field member if they would like to continue to use the field for practice.

All non-member guests must sign the General Release and agree to abide by all Field Rules.
